**Digital Orbit – Torino in digitalorbit
30 October/8 November 2009**

The Digital Orbit project grew out of the experience shared by three important events that have contributed to making the city of Torino and the region of Piemonte major focal points on the Italian and International scenes for the diffusion and communication of the latest digital technologies, with a special focus on electronic music (Situazione Xplosiva), digital art (Piemonte Share) and computer graphics (VIEW Conference).

Digital Orbit is a crossroads event encompassing the main attractions organized by three associations – the Club To Club Festival, the Share Festival, and the VIEWFest & VIEW Conference – thanks to a synergy of digital innovation experiences.

Events are geared toward the general public and toward trainers and trainees at the university and professional levels. They aim to develop dialogue between established international cultural experiences and local artistic and professional realities.

Each event provides the Digital Orbit project with a prime example of digital innovation and expertise, and is part of an intense, dialogue-based itinerary. The program offers a host of daytime activities, plus innovative evening events.

The series will be held in Torino and runs from late October through early November. It coincides with Contemporary Arts Torino Piemonte, which co-sponsors Digital Orbit events.

Digital Orbit also collaborates with the Create International Conference, held November 4 – 5 at Torino's Virtual Reality & Multi Media Park, located on Corso Lombardia 190.

Digital Orbit events are sponsored by the European Year of Creativity and Innovation 2009 and Create 2009, and are part of the countdown to the Torino European Youth Capital 2010 and the establishment of Torino's Creativity Pole.
